Responsibilities

- Create eyeglasses according to the prescriptions and fit them into frames or sunglasses
- Operate the machines that trace and edge and polish the lenses that are prescribed for each customer
- Correctly identify the lenses and frames specifications from the prescription job orders
- Be responsible for mounting the finished lenses in metal, plastic, rimless or supra (half) frames
- Inspect the eyeglasses to make sure that they conform to the specifications given by the Optometrist, as well as make modifications required (within SI standard tolerance).
- Examine customer's old pair of lenses to determine the original prescription and make a duplicate pair if necessary
- The final outcome should be as per our standard quality check parameters
- Ensure that the finished job order reaches its designated branch/store within agreed time scale
